### **Australia Pacific LNG offers further gas supply to domestic market**

Domestic buyers have expressed interest in commencing negotiations with Australia Pacific LNG following its recent offer of a significant volume of gas to help ensure Australia's east coast market remains well supplied next year.

Australia Pacific LNG chief executive officer Nick McKenna said, "During a period identified as potentially having tight gas supply, we are pleased to have been able again to offer additional volumes."

"Affordable gas is vital to Australian industry and manufacturers and this new volume of gas is in addition to the more than 100 petajoules Australia Pacific LNG has already contracted to supply to the east coast market in 2022."

Australia Pacific LNG recently sought interest from domestic customers over a four week timeframe.

"As a result of offering additional gas supply for the period 1 October 2021 until 31 December 2022, we welcome the discussions gas buyers have also started with us about their longer-term gas needs," Mr McKenna said.

Under the Heads of Agreement signed by the three Queensland LNG producers with the Commonwealth Government, Australia Pacific LNG continues to offer its uncontracted gas to domestic customers with reasonable notice on competitive market terms.
