Santos GLNG Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently 9th cargo for 2018 (180 since commencement). • Hosted 3rd round of Programmed Trainees and Apprentices on site for a familiarisation tour – included 5 GLNG trainees. • Hosted a Professional Development Tour for Regional High School Teachers. Collaborative initiative between APLNG, QGC and Santos GLNG. 31 Teachers attended. Great feedback.
QGC/Shell Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preparing for Train 2 Turnaround (shutdown), scheduled for May • Hosted 3rd round of Programmed Trainees and Apprentices on site for a familiarisation tour – included 4 QGC trainees and 4 QGC apprentices. Marks first LNG apprentices program in Gladstone • Discussed World Science Festival (2-3 March). QGC is partnering with Qld Museum to bring the event to Gladstone for a second year • Flagged QGC Communities Fund recipient breakfast (9 March). Six recipient groups receiving \$198,000. • Provided the Committee with a draft of collaborative LNG Fact Sheet. Scheduled for distribution within the Regions Visitor Information Centres.
