Australia Pacific LNG supports QLD-based manufacturer with new gas deal

Australia Pacific LNG has announced a new gas supply agreement of 1.55 PJ with Queensland Nitrates Pty Ltd (QNP), a producer of ammonium nitrate, for its facility in Central Queensland. This facility provides full-time employment for close to 100 people, all based locally.

Announcing the new deal, Chief Executive Officer Khoa Dao said Australia Pacific LNG was pleased to support the Australian manufacturer with a one-year gas supply agreement for 2023 in addition to the multi-year, competitively priced gas supply agreement executed last year.

Mr Dao said he was delighted to be supplying more gas into the domestic market and supporting Australian manufacturing jobs.

“We are one of the largest providers of gas to customers on the east coast, and it was pleasing we could provide further incremental volumes in 2023 to help the market navigate unprecedented challenges,” Mr Dao said.

In FY2022, Australia Pacific LNG provided more than 150 PJs of gas to domestic customers, mostly under medium- and long-term gas supply agreements at prices which were locked in well before this year’s market volatility.
