Australia Pacific LNG executes new domestic gas sales

Australia Pacific LNG has agreed to supply 0.9 PJ of gas to Energy Australia and 1.2 PJ to Alinta Energy. In total, through these agreements, Australia Pacific LNG will supply over 2 PJ of additional gas to the domestic market.

Chief Executive Officer Khoa Dao said the sales contracts were consistent with Australia Pacific LNG's commitment to supply the domestic market under the Heads of Agreement and at terms that reflect the recently legislated price cap.

"We are pleased to be able to provide further gas supply for the domestic market and will continue to work with customers to help them secure the gas supply they need for their businesses," Khoa said.

"In addition to these latest gas sales, APLNG provides approximately 130 PJ of gas into the domestic market during 2023 under medium and long-term gas supply agreements that clearly demonstrate our long-standing commitment to the domestic market."

Australia Pacific LNG is a net contributor to the domestic market, having provided over 1,400PJ of gas to east coast customers since LNG operations commenced in 2016.
